

The following list describes the Disposition CODES found in the weekly report under the column DISP. The code is a combination of these two references: example: 1A = Officer Written Report; 15A = Crime Check Report; 1E = Arrest by Officer; 1F = Juvenile Referral by Officer.

10. Incident Disposition Codes

- 1 = Officer contact
- 2 = Gone on arrival
- 3 = Unable to locate incident/complainant
- 4 = Assistance rendered
- 5 = Referred to another agency
- 6 = Referred to desk/crime check
- 7 = No police action required
- 8 = Assist other officer/agency
- 9 = False complainant/unfounded
- 10 = Nothing found - Complainant contacted
- 11 = Nothing found - Complainant not contacted
- 12 = Canceled/Radio-Phone
- 13 = Non Response
- 14 = Unit Broadcast (UBC)
- 15 = Crime check

- A = Miscellaneous report
- B = Additional Report
- C = Accident report
- D = No report
- E = Arrest/booking
- F = Juvenile referral
